## October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month

October is Breast Cancer Awareness Month. It
is a time when we aspire to lift up our sisters
who are currently going through treatment,
celebrate those now in remission and actively
remind us all to be vigilant because early
detection can save lives. Won't you join us?



#### PLEASE ...

- Remember to get a yearly mammogram.
- Check your breasts regularly for any lumps, thickening or swelling, redness, dimpling or discharge, change in size or shape, or pain in breast. Call the doctor or be seen at a clinic; don't put off!
- Understand your Risk Factors, which include: Family history of breast or ovarian cancer, your personal history of breast problems, age (over 50), being overweight or obese after menopause, physical inactivity, taking hormones, drinking in excess, or inherited changes in your BRCA1 and BRCA2 genes.
- Find local support at the Scully Welsh Cancer Center's "Get Your Pink On!" free event (at Cleveland Clinic Indian River Hospital). This is a an exciting evening of refreshments, shopping and health talks on Wednesday, Oct. 23, 5-7 pm. More information>

If you are currently going through treatment, and would like to be lifted up in prayer, receive Communion, need support or a listening ear, please let the parish office know. 




#### **Altar Flowers**
