



2024 was a hard year for many, and donations were down in general, which made the food that St. Augustine's gave to the Salvation Army all the more important and appreciated. Our food donations tended to fall between 130 - 175 pounds each week, and was usually all distributed to the needy by Thursday afternoon. To say, "thank you" falls far short of how much this food was appreciated. Truly, this parish has been answering Jesus' call to feed His sheep. But I still say, THANK YOU!






