Please donate: Pasta Spaghetti Sauce Peanut Butter

Please note that these figures are not guesses. We count the number of spaghetti boxes (usually a pound each), and we calculate the weight of the peanut butter and sauce by separating the jars by weight, counting the numbers of each, and then seeing how many pounds of each were actually given. It's a little labor intensive, but it gives us accurate numbers.

The congregation is to be highly praised for their steady support of this ministry, and without the full support of our leadership, this measure of success would not have happened. Our thanks to all!


